CLUB ETIQUETTE

In order for Members and Visitors to enjoy their golf, and the Club environment, the following etiquette should be observed;

- The Clubhouse and balcony are no smoking areas. Smoking is allowed outside the changing room entrance where a bin is provided.
- Although smoking on the course is allowed (other than in exceptional circumstances), used butts should be placed in the bins around the course and not discarded on the course.
- The use of mobile phones for making and receiving calls, on the course, in the Clubhouse or on the balcony, is not allowed and they should remain on silent. You may make or receive calls in the car park or in the changing rooms.
- Changing rooms are available for you to change into your golf clothing/shoes. Please do not use the car park for changing.
- Players are not allowed to share golf bags or equipment.
- Trolleys are not allowed on tees, greens, approaches to the green, in bunkers or between bunkers and the green, please ensure you walk around these areas to avoid damaging the course.
- Bunkers must always be raked after use and the rake left just inside the bunker.
- Please repair all pitch marks on greens, replace fairway divots and use the sand/seed mixture in the tee boxes to repair any tee damage.
- Shout 'FORE' if you think that a shot may potentially hit someone.
- It is the responsibility of every player to play the game at a good pace, ready golf is recommended to assist the pace of play.
- Always be aware of and considerate to the group in front and behind you, slower groups should ask the group behind to 'play through' if they are continually having to wait to play their shot/s.
- A provisional ball should always be played if you suspect you may not find your ball

Dress Code

Chelmsford Golf Club is proud to maintain its high standards and a strict dress code is enforced. Please ensure that all participants are informed of the following:

- Dirty or damp golfing attire and waterproofs are not allowed.
- Golf Shoes must not be worn in the clubhouse.
- A change of clothing after playing golf is not required but is preferred if you are using the bar area.
- Smart casual dress can be worn in the bar after you have played golf.
- When wearing tailored shorts white socks must be worn on the course at all times.
- Shirts must be tucked into trousers / shorts on the course at all times.
